Community Grant Allocations - Fiscal Year 2016

The following grant awards are part of United Way's Community Impact model, which invests in programs in Winnebago and Ogle counties to produce measurable results in the areas of education, income and health.

The competitive investment process is led by trained community volunteers who evaluate programs against several criteria such as community need and impact, program outcomes and effectiveness, and efficient resource management and collaboration. Programs are awarded funding beginning July 1.
