OGLE COUNTY IMPACT

26,000 PEOPLE, OR 50 PERCENT OF THE COUNTY'S POPULATION, ARE IMPACTED BY UNITED WAY SERVICES IN OGLE COUNTY THROUGH 17 FUNDED AGENCIES.

- ▶ HOPE of Ogle County provides United Way-funded **services to families dealing with domestic violence** issues, helping them achieve stability in their lives.
- ▶ Lifescape focuses on two deeply **senior-centered issues** with its funding: nutrition and adult protective services. Meals on Wheels **delivers nutritious meals to seniors' homes**; their adult protection programming **assists those who have experienced physical, emotional, or financial abuse**.
- ▶ The Rock River Center relies on United Way for help with its Ogle County Resource Center, **serving seniors and those with disabilities with resources and advocacy** they require, improving their quality of life.
- ▶ Shining Star Children's Advocacy Center **serves children and their families in times of personal trauma**. United Way funding helps with counseling and family advocacy efforts when children are in crisis.
