NAME OF ORGANIZATION	GRANT AMOUNT	PURPOSE
Boys and Girls Club	\$6,040	Purchase four cordless electrostatic disinfectant sprayers.
Children's Home & Aid	\$21,250	Staffing programs, providing assistance for families – food, rent, utilities, and PPE.
Children's Safe Harbor	\$5,000	Cleaning supplies, PPE, stand up hand sanitizer stations.
Crusader Community Health Foundation	\$10,000	Telehealth and emergency medications.
Easter Seals	\$10,000	Support families with children with special needs – personal care items and Autism diagnostic tools for developmental screenings.
Family Counseling Services	\$10,000	Counseling services for children, adolescents, and parents.
FLAP	\$15,000	\$500 cash supplement for 25 low income Latino workers and distribute 500 community legal education material.
Harlem Community Center	\$14,210	Personnel, supplies, and equipment.
LIAM Foundation	\$10,000	Support for essential needs, transportation, copays, mental health services.
Lifescape	\$10,000	Increase meals for 2,000+ seniors.

Meld and Bridge Shelters	\$3,000	Purchase of cleaning supplies, PPE, gloves, air purifiers, bedding, etc. for homeless youth.
Milestone, Inc.	\$15,000	PPE for medical staff and direct care workers.
Northwest Community Center	\$8,000	Day child care – staffing, materials, food services.
Prairie Street Legal Services	\$30,000	Legal help for clients with income loss and housing stability to prevent homelessness.
RAMP	\$6,000	Support for people with disabilities
Remedies Renewing Lives	\$10,000	Hand sanitizer, two touch free thermometers, PPE, gowns, medical gloves, Aspirin, Pedialyte, pre-packaged food.
Rock House Kids	\$5,000	Meals and kid-friendly food bags.
Rockford Area Habitat for Humanity	\$5,000	Short-term mortgage relief option for active Habitat borrowers.
Rockford Area Pregnancy Care Center	\$5,000	Emergency packs, diaper giveaways, summer celebration.
Rockford Rescue Mission	\$5,000	Single-use trays, disposable cups, bowls, utensils, and take-out containers.
Salvation Army	\$10,000	Rental and utilities assistance, food and pantry supplies.
Shelter Care Ministries	\$6,500	Rental assistance, cleaning supplies, disposable dishes and utensils, PPE, sanitizer.
YMCA of Rock River Valley	\$15,000	Summer children’s program – providing educational and recreational programming.
Youth Services Network, Inc.	\$5,000	Purchase of PPE, sanitizer, and cleaning supplies.
YWCA of Northwestern Illinois	\$10,000	Assist families in La Voz Latina program due to loss of employment.
